


# Financial Review

\$11,982

We raised a total of nearly twelve thousand dollars in the year 2019. 60%

This is 60 percent more than we raised by the end of our first year of service in 2018, which was a total of \$6,449.

We are so proud of the year we had in 2019. As a new nonprofit that officially began in May of 2018, our first 7 months in 2018 were focused on learning, growing, and increasing our brand awareness and volunteers. 2018 consisted of raising money while establishing annual events. Beginning in 2019, we began using the money we raised to give back to families in need.

In 2019, we donated to 34 families and also donated \$2,500 to research for Huntington's Disease. Many of these families were facing eviction, no money for food or electricity, were awaiting disability, or in need of new handicap equipment and accessibility. It was an honor to be able to serve so many people in our community.


